- That allows LotusScript code to interact with COM applications, MS Office would be an obvious example



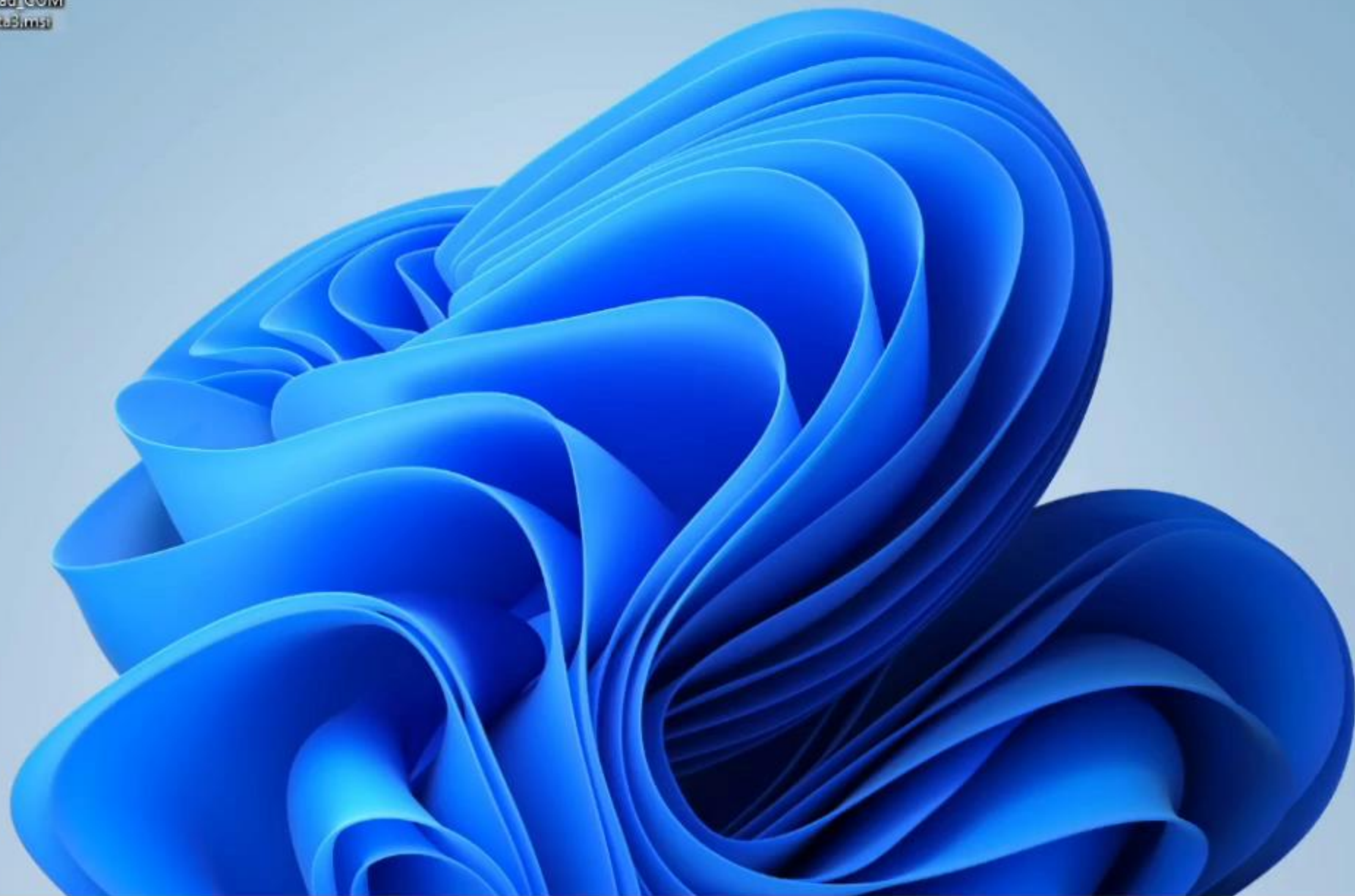

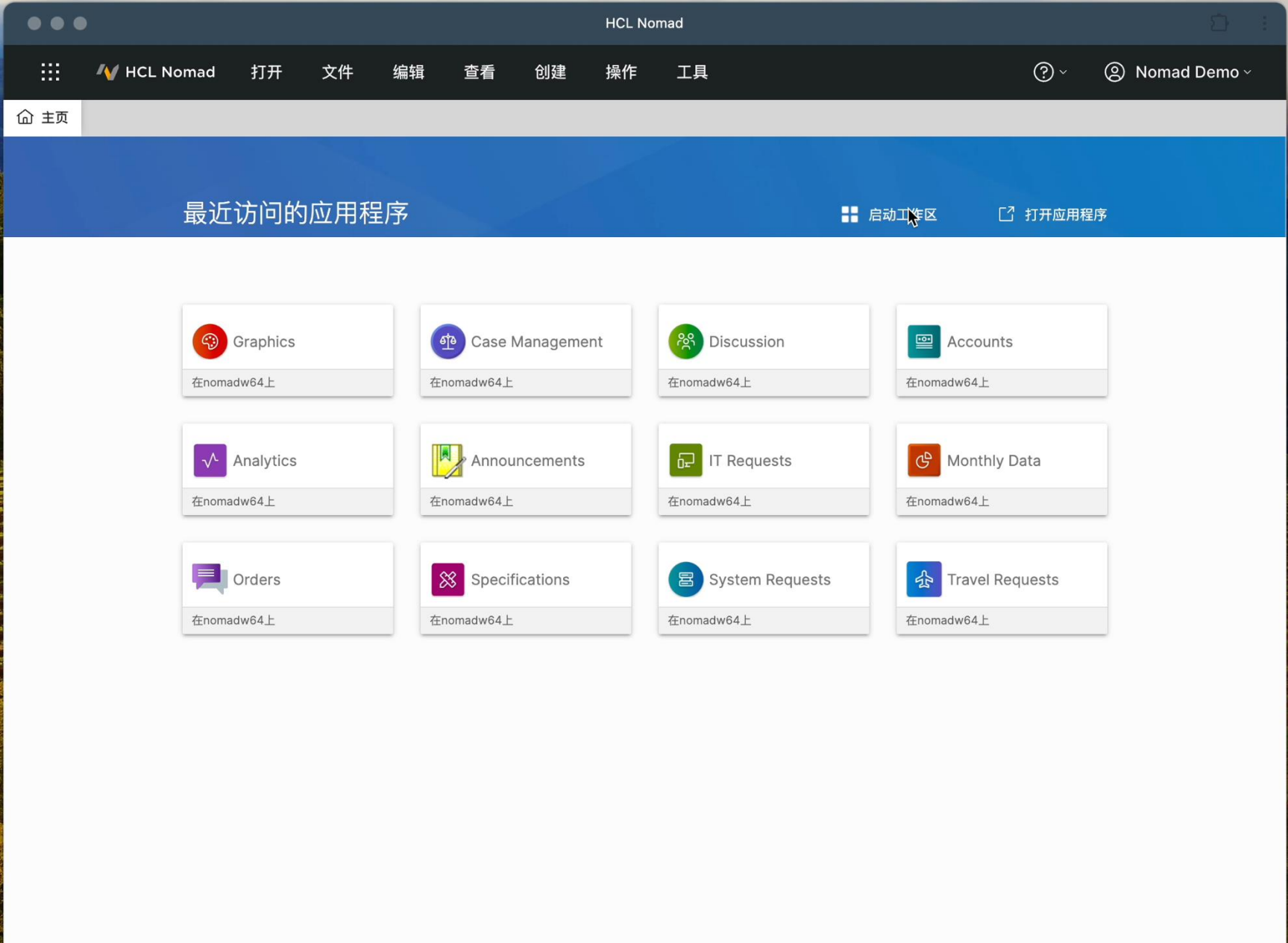
Nomad web designer support for additional browser languages

◆ Using Nomad for Android/iOS

1. Download and install HCL Nomad from the **Google Play Store** or **Apple App Store**.
2. Open Nomad on your device.
3. Complete the **“Domino Client Setup”** page or the **“Nomad Proxy Setup”** page.
4. Enter your **Notes user ID password** when prompted.
5. Wait for the configuration to complete and the Home page to open.

Note: If your ID file is in an ID vault, it is downloaded automatically during setup. If your ID file is not in an ID vault, you'll need to copy it to your device.

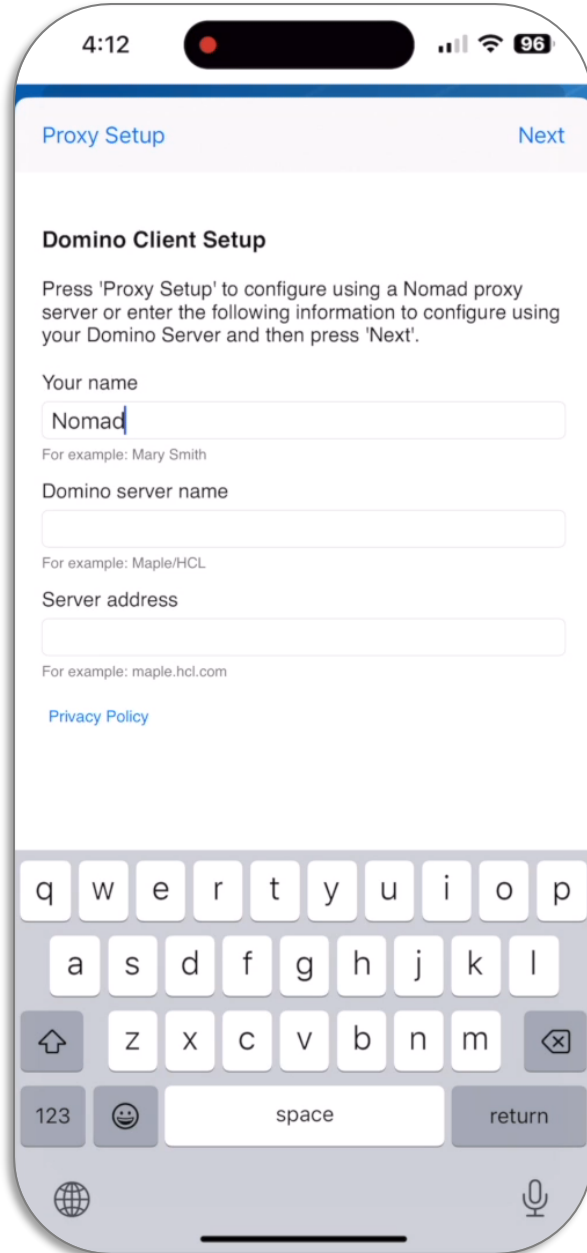

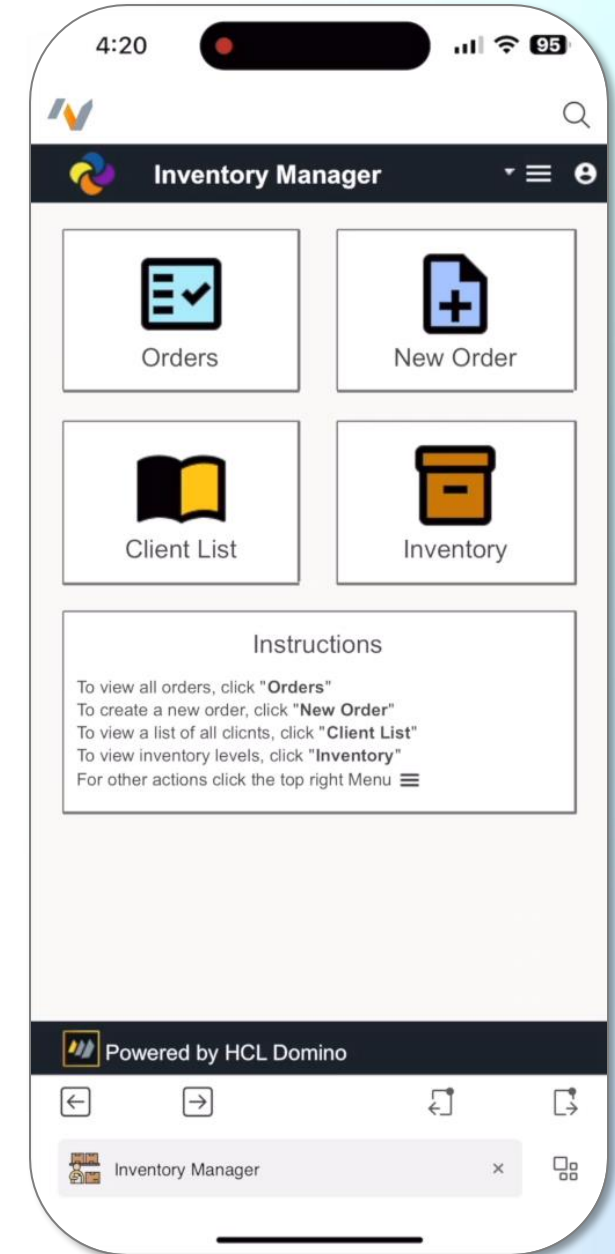
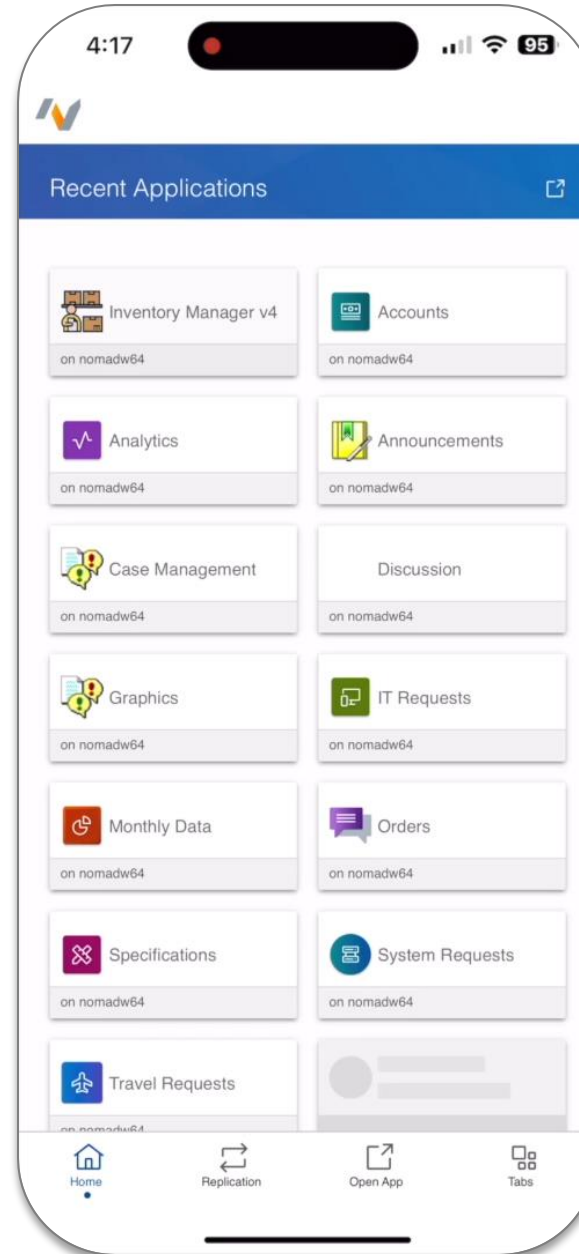
◆ Using Nomad for Android/iOS



- **Support for biometric authentication.** Users can utilize Face ID or Touch ID to unlock their Notes ID.
- **Updated Nomad Menu.** Menu items have moved around — **Replication** and **Open Application** can now be opened directly from the **Global Action Bar** at the bottom of the screen.
- A new **"Show Tutorial"** option has been added, allowing users to view the What's New dialog on demand. This dialog also appears automatically whenever the app is updated with new features.
- The new **Global Action Bar** is shown at the bottom of the screen to navigate to Home (Recent Applications), Replication, Open App, or Tabs.
- **panagenda's MarvelClient** enables administrators to centrally manage and pre-configure Nomad clients for streamlined deployment, ensuring users can start working productively right away.

Using Nomad for Android/iOS

- **Make Available Offline** allows users to create a local replica of the application.
- **Updated Tab Bar.** For mobile phones, tabs are now located at the bottom of the screen. Switch tabs either by swiping or by tapping on the **Tab Overview** button.
- The **Tab Overview** shows the open tabs of all applications. Tabs are grouped by application, sorted by last accessed.
- Support for **pinch-to-zoom gesture** in scrollable document content making it easier to focus on key sections or view an entire document at a glance.
- The **@PickList** dialog now supports a **starts with** search to jump to the first matching entry.

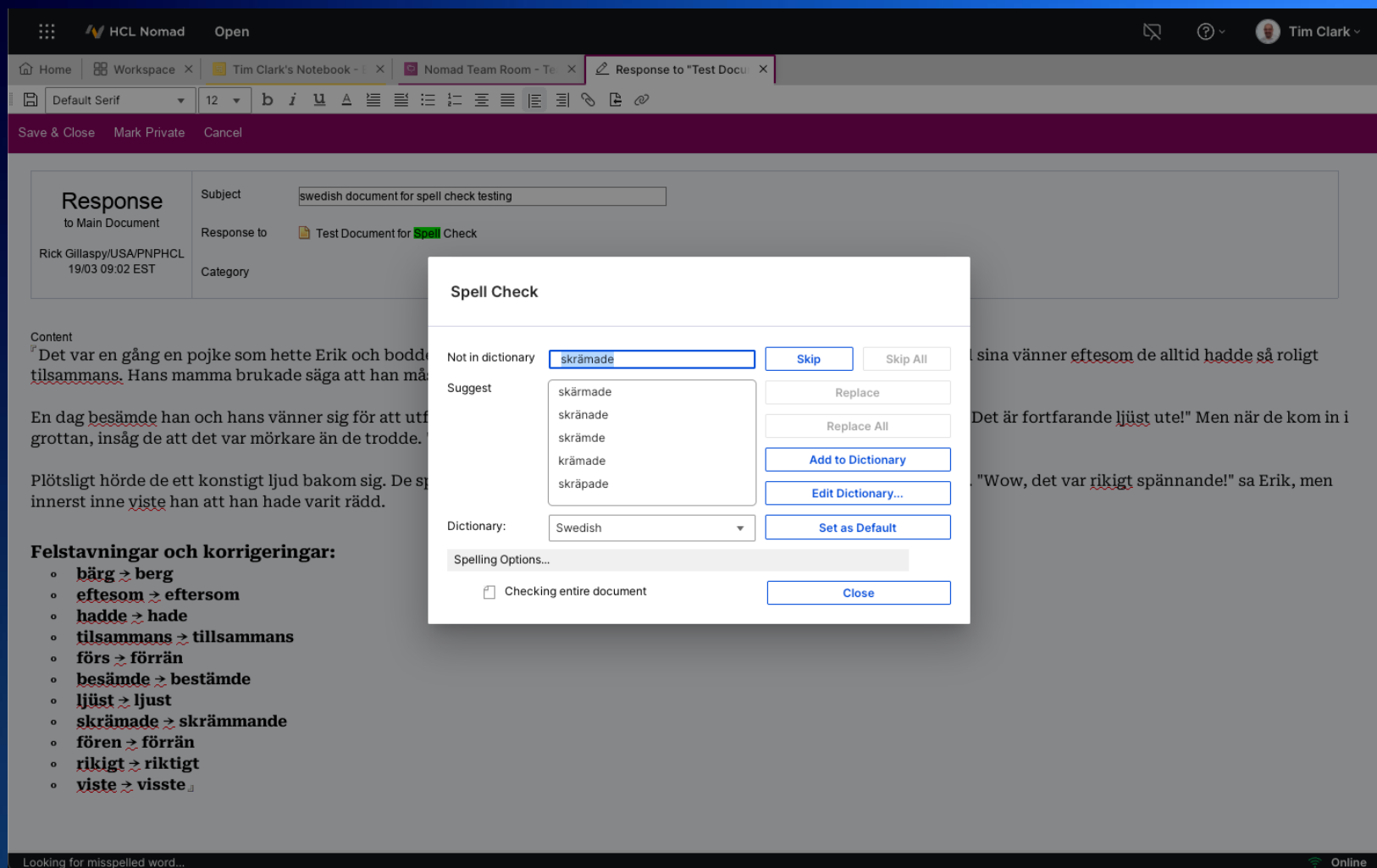

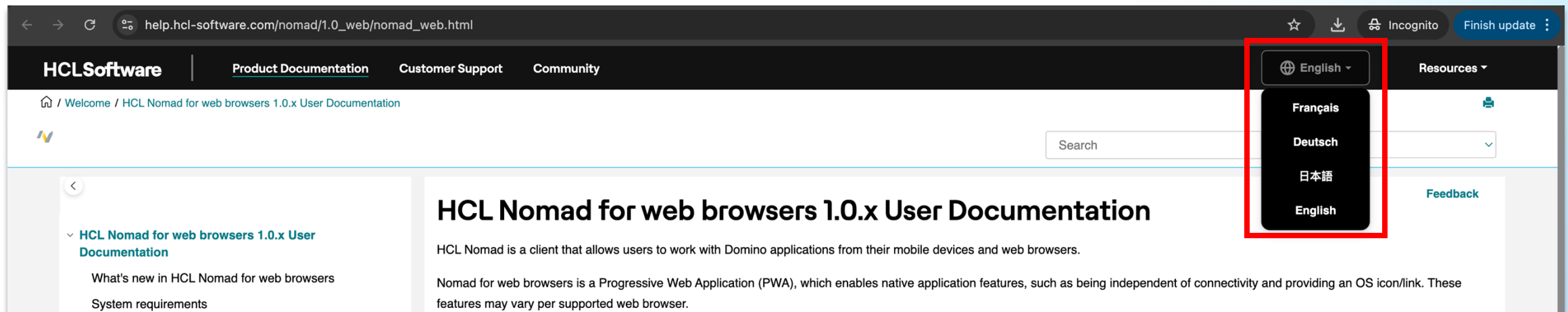


